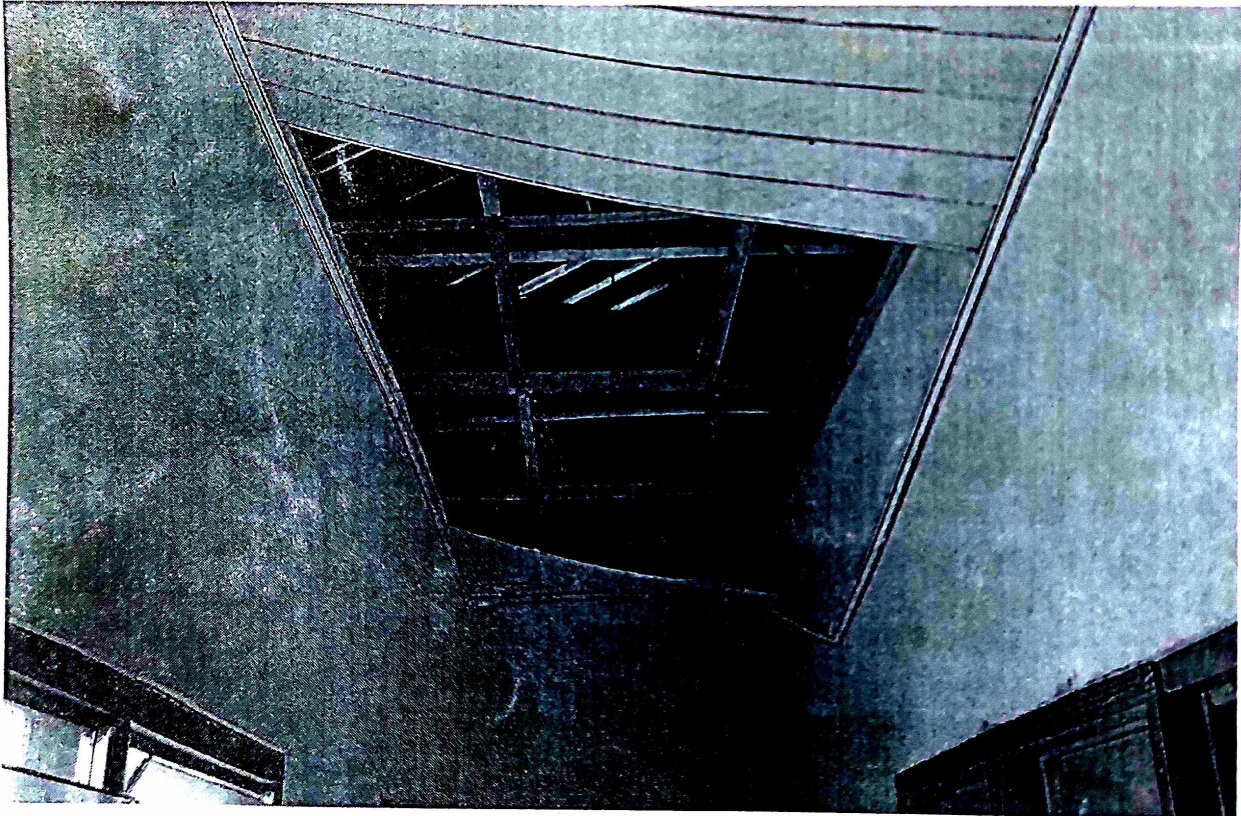


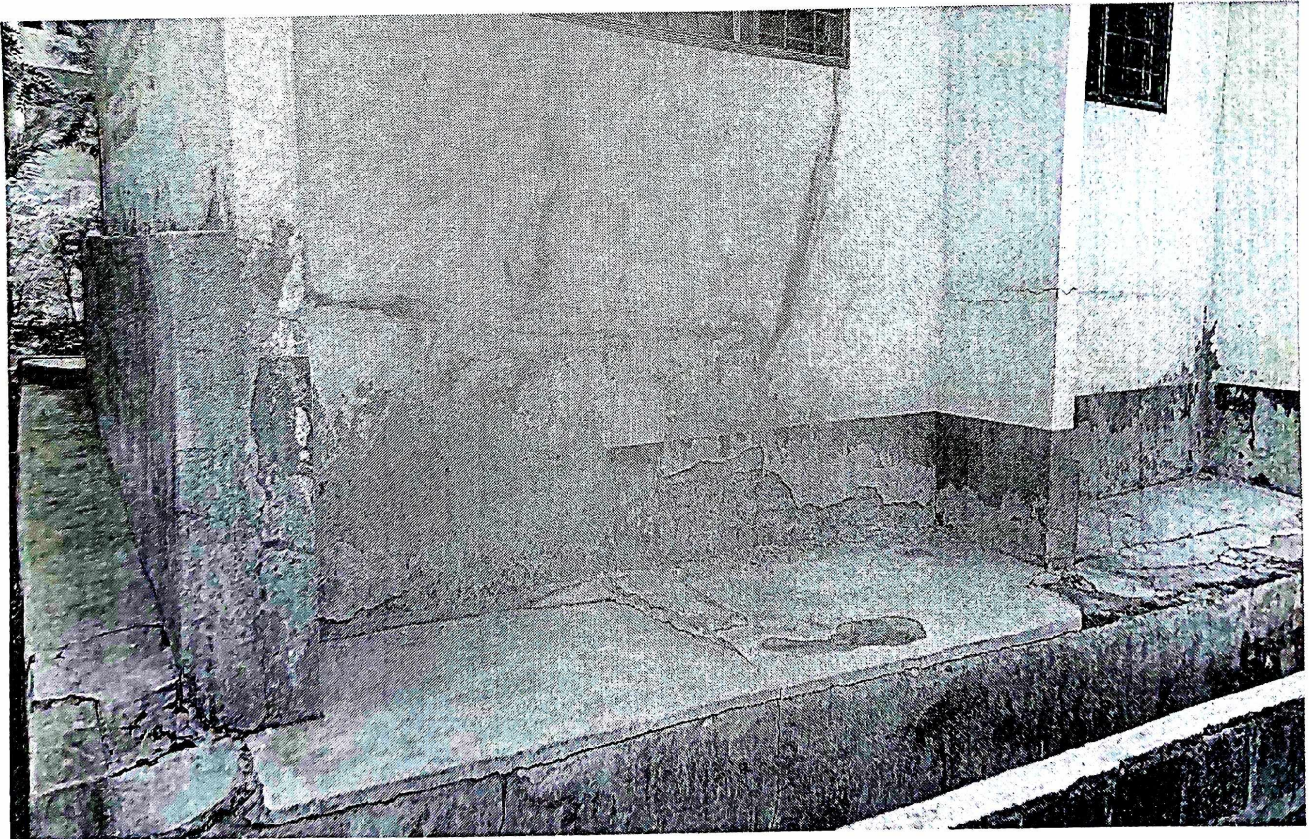
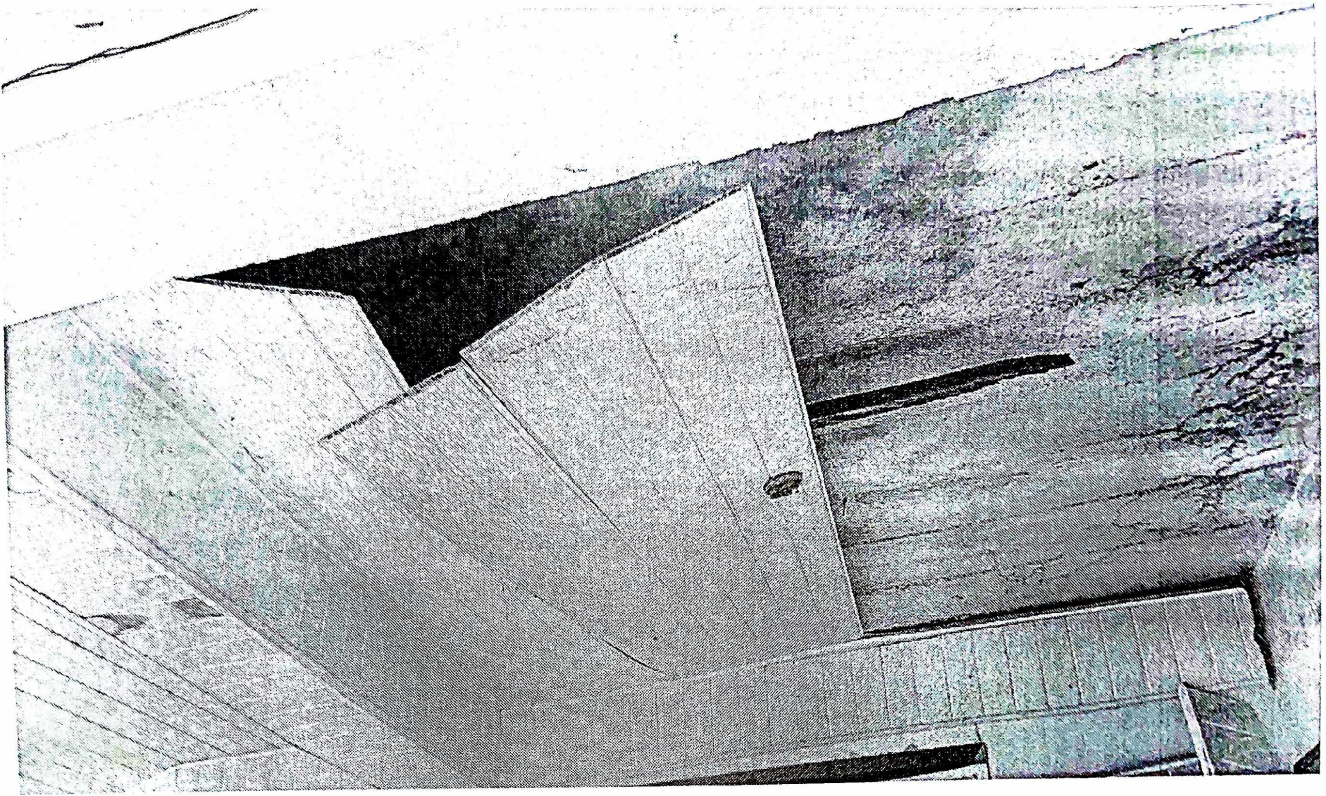
**REPORT OF THE AGRIC SUB COMMITTEE MEETING HELD ON WEDNESDAY
23RD APRIL 2025, AT THE DISTRICT AGRIC DEPARTMENT HALL, NYINAHIN.**

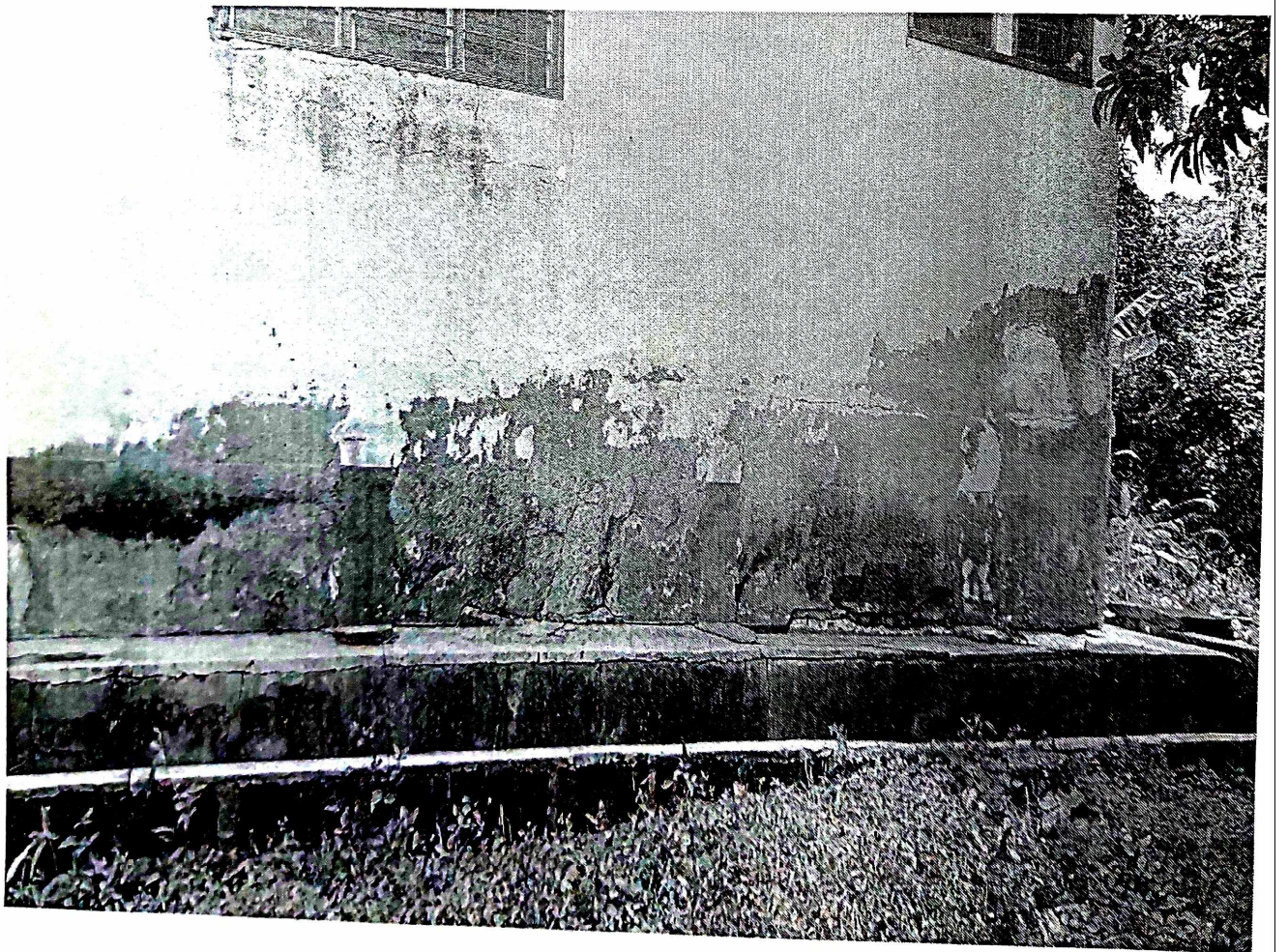
The Agric sub committee met on 23rd April, 2025 and came up with the following recommendations for further deliberations and considerations by the executive committee of the Assembly.

1. Discussion on Renovation of Agric Office.

The Committee recommends that the Assembly should treat this as a matter of urgent by renovating the office complex, since it is in the deplorable state. The Agric director further explain that worker in the office now prefer to sit under trees during working hours due to the deplorable state of the building, below are some of the pictures of the in and out of the office complex.







2. Enhancement of Rice Production in the District

The committee wishes to recommend that the Assembly should support the farmers in the District by helping them with both the chemicals and the logistics that will be needed in making their farming work easy for them.

- It was recommended that the Assembly should facilitate the procuring of rice threshers to the rice farmers to help them increase productivity and also generate more income in the District. The members said they are willing to pay for a charge if the Assembly decides to buy the rice thresher and rent it to them.
- It was also recommended that if the Assembly do not have the financial muscles in purchasing the rice thrasher, the should solicit for financial support from the mining companies in the District, as a form of cooperate social responsibility.
- The meeting recommended that the Assembly should find a motivational tool to enticed the youth in to farming business, the reason being that most of the youth in the farming communities are losing interest in the farming due to the illegal mining (galamsay). They appeal the Assembly to lay down some mechanisms that will draw the youth back into farming for a better and brighter future.

3. Farmers day celebration in the District

The meeting further recommends that there should be collaboration between the committee and the Assembly in selecting awardees for this year's farmer's day celebration and should be transparent to all involved in the food value chain to avert issues of disagreement among the general public.

CONCLUSION

The Agric Sub Committee after careful deliberations on the situational report on Agriculture in the District has come up with the above recommendations for considerations by the Executive Committee.
