

**REPORT OF JUSTICE AND SECURITY SUB-COMMITTEE MEETING
HELD ON MONDAY, 16TH DECEMBER, 2025 AT THE ATWIMA
MPONUA DISTRICT ASSEMBLY'S CONFERENCE ROOM,
NYINAHIN.**

Introduction

On Monday, 16th December, 2025, the Justice and Security sub-committee met at the Atwima Mponua District Assembly's conference.

After extensive and thorough deliberation, the sub-committee arrived at the following recommendations towards the agendas discussed at the meeting.

1. Security situation at the office of the District Assembly.

The NADMO officer recommended that as a matter of urgency, the Assembly should liaise with the District Police service to provide them with personnel from the Youth Employment Police assistants whereby the personnel will be motivated to provide security to the Assembly during the day while the Assembly continues to search for a permanent security personnel with a convincing and early salary payment to provide day and night security to the Assembly.

2. Procurement of Plant (Generator) for the Assembly.

Members unanimously agreed and approved of the procurement of Plant to enable the Assembly discharge their functions effectively and also to boost security.

3. Procurement and supply of electricity poles for needed communities.

Members unanimously agreed and gave their approval for the procurement and supply of electric poles for the needed communities by the Assembly after hazard mapping assessment done by the appropriate institution to reduce the risk of fire outbreaks, destruction of transformers from excessive tapping of electricity from one source.

The meeting was brought to closure after the above-mentioned recommendations were made.
