

**REPORT OF JUSTICE AND SECURITY SUB-COMMITTEE MEETING
HELD ON MONDAY, 20TH APRIL, 2026 AT THE ATWIMA MPONUA
DISTRICT ASSEMBLY'S CONFERENCE ROOM, NYINAHIN.**

Introduction

On Monday, 20th April, 2026, the Justice and Security sub-committee held a meeting at the Atwima Mponua District Assembly's conference room.

The meeting started at exactly 9:35am with an opening prayer said by Hon. Badu Richard.

After extensive and thorough deliberations, the sub-committee arrived at the following recommendations towards the agendas discussed at the meeting.

1. Security situation in the District.

- In the attempt to tackle the insecurities in the district, members called upon the Assembly and Honourable DCE to commission Police stations already built within the district that are not functioning to operate effectively and equip the security personnel in the district with the essential logistics and equipment such as motorbikes to enable them discharge their duties effectively.
- Members also suggested that security check-points should be positioned or mounted at hot areas in the district to help tackle the insecurities.
- Members recommended that people within the communities in the district should be watchful and observant to monitor foreigners in the district and also there should be formation of watchdog committees in the district.

2. Inauguration and Operationalization of the various Area councils.

Members unanimously agreed on the need for the Assembly to inaugurate the various Area councils in the district and make it operational.

The meeting was brought to closure after the above recommendations were issued out by the members.
