

REPORT OF THE WORKS SUB-COMMITTEE MEETING HELD ON THURSDAY 18TH DECEMBER 2025 AT THE CONFERENCE HALL

OVERVIEW

The Works Sub-Committee met on Friday, 18th December, 2025 to have a meeting regarding the development of Atwima Mponua District and have come out with briefings and recommendations after intensive deliberations.

COMPLETED PROJECTS

- Completion of police station at Mpasatia.
- Construction of 2-unit Doctor's bungalow with interior furnishing at Anwiafutu.

DELAYED PROJECTS

All the delayed projects in the district will be re-packaged and awarded under the Government's legacy projects program.

DRIP MACHINES OPERATIONALIZATION

The communities that need the machines for their roads should contact the District Engineer to estimate the cost the community would have to spend on the required machines for the reshaping.

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Members recommended that there should be extension of electricity district wide and supplying of meters.
2. The committee recommended that, the Assembly should create taskforce to enforce laws and also maximize revenue generation in the District.
3. The committee recommended that, the works sub-committee will from now be monitoring project sites every quarter before any meeting and pleads with the Assembly to make provision of vehicle to that effect.
4. It was recommended that, the erosion from the fire service station across the highway should be checked.
5. Members recommended that, as a matter of urgency, the frontage of the Agenda 111 project should be cleared and cut down to have accurate view of the road to prevent accident when accessing the Assembly/DCE's junction.
6. The committee recommended that, the Assembly should construct more K.G blocks in the district to help the children get good start in education.
7. It was recommended for immediate attention on the serious erosion taking place along the highway in-between Yaw Barimakrom and Agogoso.

CONCLUSION

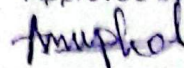
The committee concluded that, all the aforementioned recommendations should be accessed and taken into consideration.
