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**A REPORT OF THE SOCIAL SERVICES SUB-COMMITTEE MEETING HELD ON
TUESDAY, 14TH APRIL 2026, AT THE DISTRICT ASSEMBLY HALL AND
SUBMITTED TO THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF THE ASSEMBLY.**

The Social Services Sub-committee in its effort to help achieve the Social issues in the District met on Tuesday, 14th April 2026 and discussed issues and came out with the following recommendations.

1. Provision of teacher's accommodation in deprived communities

Accommodation for teachers in deprived communities in the Atwima Mponua District had been raised severally but still not avail.

- ❖ The meeting therefore recommended that, the Assembly should make a 3 - 5 years plan and locate the deprived communities who are earnestly in need of the teacher's quarters and start construction within the period.
- ❖ It was also recommended that, communities such as Bedabour, Mpasatia, Akota etc. who have started teacher's quarters projects at their electoral areas should be considered first, in terms of providing building materials like cement and iron rods.

2. Sensitization of Assembly members on Human Immune Virus

The Health Directorate reported that, the rate at which Human Immune Virus (HIV) cases has risen in Atwima Mponua District needs an urgent solution.

- ❖ The meeting recommended a day sensitization for the Hon. Assembly Members during General Assembly meeting by the Health Directorate and support the Directorate and N.C.C.E. financially for sensitization at various communities in the district especially at illegal mining zones.

CONCLUSION

The Committee hopes that the outlined recommendations above shall be accepted by the Executive Committee of the Assembly for onward transmission to the General Assembly of the district.
